Spotlight

Every month we want to highlight a group or organization that is using de Grote Broek and organizing activities. This month: Stichting Gast (Gast Foundation). Stichting Gast is an organisation that helps refugees in need in and around Nijmegen. These refugees have exhausted all legal remedies, but cannot or dare not to go back. These people often still have a real chance of obtaining a residence permit in the Netherlands. But the Dutch government abandons them nevertheless.

Stichting Gast works together with other groups, for example Dokters van de Wereld, and helps people without documents with medical, social and legal assistance. At the same time, they are committed to a humane asylum policy. The Gast Foundation does not receive a government subsidy and is therefore dependent on donations and the efforts of volunteers.
